

IPA – Radioclub – Contest

The International-Police-Association-Radioclub (IPARC), german section, invites all radio amateurs worldwide to take part on IPARC-Contest at first complete weekend in November every year.

1. Modes and contest time

CW : saturday 05:00 UTC – 12:00 UTC

SSB: sunday 05:00 UTC – 12:00 UTC

Both parts are separate contests !

2. Bands	CW	SSB
80m	3510 kHz – 3560 kHz	3700 kHz – 3800 kHz
40m	7000 kHz – 7025 kHz	7060 kHz – 7100 kHz, 7130 kHz – 7200 kHz
20m	14000 kHz – 14060 kHz	14125 kHz – 14300 kHz
15m	21000 kHz – 21070 kHz	21155 kHz – 21300 kHz
10m	28000 kHz – 28070 kHz	28320 kHz – 28600 kHz

Please use only the contest areas during the contest (IARU – rules) !

3. Classes

A- CW Club- and special callsigns (Multi/Multi, Multi/Single)

A – SSB Club- and special callsigns (Multi/Multi, Multi/Single)

B – CW individual callsigns (only single operator)

B – SSB individual callsigns (only single operator)

C – CW SWL

C – SSB SWL

Remark: Contest participation only with one callsign !

No difference between IPARC- members and no IPARC members !

Winner are the first 3 stations in every participation class.

4. Call

CQ IPA TEST / CQ IPA CONTEST

5. Reports

RS(T) with running number, beginning with 001 in CW AND ALSO in SSB
(both are separate contests)

IPARC- members give also „IPA“, stations from United States of America also their state
(like in WAS list)

Work every station one time per band and mode.

QSO with operator of an club station is allowed only (!) to get points for award application.
Theses QSOs count not for the contest and it`s not allowed to bring them in the log !

6. Points and Multipliers

QSO with IPARC station : 5 points

QSO with all other : 1 point

Multiplier are the countries with IPARC callsigns and US-states with IPARC callsigns
Example: DL0IPA counts 5 points and DL as multiplier.

WA8IPA counts 5 points, USA as country and MI as US state as multiplier

DL1XYZ (no IPARC member) counts 1 point (no DL multiplier)

final result: total of QSO points X total of multiplier points PER BAND
For final score add the band results.

Logs must be submitted in Cabrillo or text file.
No ADIF or other form accepted.
